WHAT DOES A DRIVER DO?

- Safely operate commercial vehicles to transport goods or passengers.
- Follow all traffic laws, safety regulations, and company policies.
- Inspect and maintain vehicles to ensure they are safe and road-ready.
- Communicate clearly with dispatch, customers, or team members.

WHAT'S REQUIRED?

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Valid CDL (Commercial Driver's License) with the proper class and endorsements.
- Clean driving record and ability to pass background checks.
- Ability to pass DOT physical and drug/alcohol screenings.
